ConnectSite 100 BTS SW releases.

Description: CX4.0-5 release testing has finished and test results have been

reviewed. Unfortunately one problem was found, which needs to be corrected before CX4.0-5 SW can be released.

The New CX4.0-5 schedule has a direct impact on later CX release schedules, therefore new release dates have been defined.

At the same time Nokia has decided to rename some of the releases to better indicate the nature of each release.

BTS SW Release CX4.0-5

For CX4.0-5 release content, see the updated UltraSite EDGE BTS GFR issue 23-0, ref. /1/.

The new release date of CX4.0-5 is 30th of June 2005. On the release date, BTS SW with the release documentation will be published in NOLS.

BTS SW Release CX4.1

Nokia has decided to combine CX4.1 and CX4.2 to one release packet. The release name will be CX4.1.

CX4.1 will include the following new features:

- IDD with Base Band Hopping
- Dynamic Frequency and Channel Allocation (DFCA)
- Extended Cell Range for UltraSite EDGE BTS
- STM-1 support
- **RSSI** enhancements
- BSS Site Sync Recovery Improvement for UltraSite



The software will also include fault corrections to existing problems. See the attached Generic Failure Report for details.

Schedule of CX4.1

CX4.1 SW will be released for <u>ANSI</u> markets on 15th of August 2005. SiteWizard 4.1 will be published at the same time.

CX4.1 SW for global markets will be released 31st of August 2005.

BTS SW Release CX4.1 CD1.0

Nokia has scheduled a <u>global</u> Change Delivery CX4.1 CD1.0 for possible fault corrections after CX4.1.

Schedule of CX4.1 CD1.0

The estimated time for publishing the CX4.1 CD1.0 SW is 31st of October 2005.

BTS SW Release CX4.2

This is former CX4.3 release. Nokia will issue a Global Enhancement Delivery CX4.2:

- Separate Radio Link Time Out Parameters for EFR & AMR
- GPRS Coding Schemes 3 & 4
