Resolution And Repair Procedure

Upgrade to the appropriate version as listed in the <u>"Software Parts Required"</u> section below, based on the model. Order of upgrade:

- 1. Check the current UNC (Unified Network Configurator) version on the system. If the system is running a version lower than listed in the section Software Parts Required below, upgrade UNC to the minimum version specified below or later. Otherwise, go to the next step.
- 2. Generate TNCT configuration using the version listed in the section Software Parts Required below.
- 3. Upgrade Fortinet OS for all firewalls in the system which match the firewalls specified in the section Models / System Releases / Kits / Datecodes Affected above.

Follow the order:

- a. Upgrade OS
- b. Deploy configuration
- c. Reboot FW

To obtain software:

NOTE 2

Fortinet F101e upgrade time is 12 minutes (single node), 14 minutes (cluster). This includes a config update.

OS 7.0.12 size: 70 MB.

NOTE 3

Known issue:

After upgrading FortiOS to 7.0.12 on RNI-DMZ and Internetworking firewalls in HA mode, the first upload of configuration for the 7.0.12 OS task via UNC will fail with the following error:

```
>>> "set" "dhcp-renew-time" "0" @ 11517:system.interface.mgmt:value parse error
(error -61)
```

Workaround:

Retry the configuration upload. The second configuration upload succeeds and subsequent configuration uploads are successful.
