MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS TECHNICAL NOTIFICATION (MTN)

Title

Reboot of Juniper EX 4100-F switch may cause network disruption even though the other switch in the redundant pair is fully operational.

Technology

ASTRO® 25 - Juniper EX 4100-F switch

Severity Recommendation

High/Safety - Perform Immediately

Symptoms

During a reboot of the Juniper EX 4100-F switch at a console site, audio to the console will be lost for up to 2 mins. If the Juniper EX 4100-F switch is located at the CORE site, the system may lose connection to the network management applications e.g. UEM for up to 2 mins.

During a reboot, the Juniper EX 4100-F switch enables Ethernet ports before being ready to accept frames. In the redundant pair of switches/switch stacks, this will cause disruption in applications detecting link status for link redundancy management, leading to temporary (up to 2mins) gap in communication, despite the redundant switch being fully operational. This behavior affects switch software 22.4R2-S2 (22.4R2-S2.6) which has not been patched.

Test To Perform

To confirm if the patch 22.4R2-S2-J1.2 has been already applied log into EX via SSH with correct credentials and run the command show version. If the output shows selective update installed (see example below), upgrade is not required.

Upgrade to the certified software version (if needed) and apply the patch included with the appropriate version as listed in the "Software/Hardware Parts Required" section below, based on the model.

- 1. Upgrade Juniper EX 4100-F JunOS for all switches/switch stacks in the system.
 - For every switch/switch stack:
 - Upgrade JunOS
 - Reboot switch/switch stack (after successful JunOS upgrade).

Estimated time to implement - 12-18 min. per switch/switch stack.
