# HOW TO INSTALL DEPOT 14 AND CHANGE SERIAL NUMBER TO ACTIVATE FEATURES


You must have MotoTRBO CPS installed!

#### MotoTRBO Depot 14

- 1) Depot 14 → <a href="https://mega.nz/file/BsQwkYLZ#\_juctpctshT243DAoDag-YEgCZGCCeZkDBjebsnDiGE">https://mega.nz/file/BsQwkYLZ#\_juctpctshT243DAoDag-YEgCZGCCeZkDBjebsnDiGE</a>
  - a) unzip and then install MOTOTRBO DepotTool 14.0.exe
  - b) you will get invalid license. Just exit.
    - 1. You may have to go to processes and kill mototrbodepotteool.exe
  - c) copy and replace mototrbodepottool.exe in zip file to
    - 1. C:\Program Files (x86)\Motorola\MOTOTRBO DepotTool
    - 2. 32 bit C:\Program Files\Motorola\MOTOTRBO DepotTool

#### Install Depot 9 and upgrade to Depot 14

2) Install MotoTRBO Depot 9. Keep the lmgr11.dll handy!



- b) Close MotoTRBO depot
- 3) unzip MotoTRBO-Depot14.zip (or what your depot 14 is named)
- 4) cut (CTRL+X) and replace folder "MOTOTRBO DepotTool"
  - a) You will paste while in the C:\Program Files (x86)\Motorola\ folder
    - 1. 32-bit machine C:\Program Files\Motorola\
  - b) C:\Program Files (x86)\Motorola\MOTOTRBO DepotTool\MOTOTRBO DepotTool\← you do not want two consecutive MOTOTRBO DepotTool folders!!!
- 5) copy and replace lmgr11.dll from MOTOTRBO DepotTool9 zip file to
  - a) C:\Program Files (x86)\Motorola\MOTOTRBO DepotTool
  - b) 32-bit machine C:\Program Files\Motorola\MOTOTRBO DepotTool
- 6) Now you have MotoTRBO Depot 14 installed!


## Changing serial number and registering features

- 1. Hook radio to PC like regular programming with CPS. Do not open CPS.
- 2. Save tuner info.
- 3. Write down current serial number! You may have to open CPS to read this and then close CPS before proceeding to step 3.
- 4. Look at options here → http://agh-technik.orgfree.com/texte/userdata.txt
- 5. Ensure you have replaced userdata.sdf → follow instructions here → <a href="https://www.austech.info/showthread.php/118172-Mototrbo-TTS?">https://www.austech.info/showthread.php/118172-Mototrbo-TTS?</a> p=818428&viewfull=1#post818428

ok, I will try to explain how.

1) you need motorola depottool 14 for changing SN (11111111111 or 22222222222 or 123ABC1234 ...)
2) you also need motorola cps 2.0
3) go to C:\ProgramData\Motorola\MOTOTRBO for cps 2.0 and delete the userdata.sdf
4) go to motorola cps 2.0 restore device licenses
5) go to C:\ProgramData\Motorola\MOTOTRBO for cps 2.0 and copy the new file userdata.sdf
6) you need motorola cps 16
7) go to C:\ProgramData\Motorola\MOTOTRBO for cps 16 and replace the userdata.sdf (new created one)
8) go to cps 16 to activate device function
thats it!
