

INTERCOMPANY SERVICES COORDINATION PLAN

UNIVERSAL SERVICE ORDER

PACIFIC TELEPHONE COMPANY FORMAT

1. GENERAL

1.01 This appendix describes the Pacific Telephone and Nevada Bell Companies' (PAC) Intercompany Services Coordination--Universal Service Order (ISC-USO).

1.02 PACs ISC-USO differs slightly in format from the American Telephone & Telegraph Company's (AT&T) ISC-USO. This difference is required because of other systems (eg, Service Order Retrieval and Distribution system, Accounting Customer Records and Billing System, etc) in PAC that are structured to process this format.

2. PACs ISC-USO

2.01 *General:* PACs ISC-USO may be distributed to the field via the Service Order Retrieval and Distribution (SORD) or PAC-Net network.

2.02 *SORD Distribution of ISC-USO:* For those PAC locations where the order will be distributed to SORD printers, the order will be printed on a Form CO 4033 that has preprinted field identifiers (FID) for the fielded portion of the identification (ID) section. Exhibit 1 presents an example of a SORD distributed ISC-USO.

2.03 *PAC-Net Distribution of ISC-USO:* For those PAC locations where distribution will not be to SORD printers, the order will be typed on blank stock or Form P 2466 associated with a PAC-Net terminal and will have the FIDs for the fielded portion of the ID section typed on the order. Exhibit 2 presents an example of a PAC-Net distributed ISC-USO.

2.04 *Sequence of Sections:* The PAC ISC-USO will contain the following sections, as required, in the sequence listed below:

(a) Order identification section:

(1) Fielded Portion -- Will have two lines of field headings with the required data typed in the spaces associated with them (on forms associated with SORD printers), or typed underneath them (blank stock of Form P 2466 -- PAC-Net terminal).

(2) Nonfielded Portion -- Will be the first entries in the body of the order immediately following the fielded portion.

(b) List section (---LIST)

(c) Control section (---CTL)

(d) Traffic section (---TRF)

(e) Service and equipment section (---S&E)

(f) Billing section (---BILL)

(g) Remarks section (---RMKS)

2.05 *Field Identifiers (FIDs):* FIDs are codes used to identify data required on ISC-USOs. There are some differences in the FIDs used by AT&T and PAC. Table A presents a list, by sections, of differences in FIDs or FID usage. This list presents only those FIDs it is felt require additional clarification for processing the order in the field. The AT&T Universal Service Order Manual, the Pacific Company USO 804.00 practice and Section 680-595-959PT, Appendix 1, presents a complete list of FIDs for AT&T and PAC ISC-USOs, respectively.

2.06 *Description of PAC Field Identifiers:* The following descriptions are for only those FIDs that require additional clarification:

(a) Field Identification Section:

(1) TD – TAKEN DATE: The date on which customer has provided negotiator

with a firm order and sufficient information to proceed with provision of service.

(2) ACCD – ACCOUNT CODE: Used on orders when accounts require special Accounting treatment.

(3) AO – AS OF DATE: The date current billing will change or stop.

(b) Nonfielded Identification Section:

(1) ZAPT — APPOINTMENT CODE: Additional due date information that may be required to satisfy customer's specifications, such as:

- COB — Close Of business
- OOB — Opening Of business
- 8A EST — 8:00 AM Eastern Standard Time

(2) ZBN — BILL NAME: Used in the nonfielded ID section to identify the customer for order filing purposes; *will not be used* when there is an entry in the BILLING section identifying customer bill name.

(3) ZDC—SPECIAL DISTRIBUTION CODE: SORD or PAC-Net terminal codes, entered for distributing the order to locations that cannot be identified by mechanized distribution process. There are three distributions involved with ISC-USOs.

- Prior (P) — Distribution to entities having *design responsibilities* and to *independent companies* if involved
- Installation (I) — Distribution to entities having *installation* responsibilities
- Completion (C) — Distribution to entities having *completion* responsibilities.

(c) Control Section:

(1) RRI — REBATE REQUIRED INTERVAL: Used to designate period of interruption allowed on Pacific Company Private Line Services and facilities provided to an OCC.

(2) ZESC — ENGINEERING SERVICE CLASS: Used to define class and specific type of service for circuit design purposes.

(d) Service and Equipment Section:

- ZPL — PRIVATE LINE NUMBER: Used to identify the Private Line number assigned to each circuit that is used by Accounting for filing control purposes.
