

SAFETY HEADGEAR DESCRIPTION AND USE

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 081-020-010, Issue 2

1.002 This addendum is issued to delete reference to the use of detergents for the cleaning of safety headgear.

2. CHANGES TO SECTION

2.001 On Page 9, change 4.02 as follows; add Caution:

Safety headgear may be cleaned by washing with warm, soapy water. To clean, remove the suspension

and dip the crown in the soapy solution. If necessary, scrub with a cloth or soft brush. To remove all soap, rinse thoroughly in clear, warm water and wipe dry. The suspension may also be washed with soap and water.

Caution: Do not use strong detergents or stiff brushes for cleaning. Detergents may cause stress cracking. Stiff brushes may scratch the shell or striping.
