1. GENERAL

1.1 The purpose of this UIS is to provide information on the R-5157 Microfilm Viewer Printer.

2. R-5157 DESKTOP MICROFILM READER PRINTER

2.1 The R-5157 Viewer-Printer is a desk top unit which shall be used to provide hard copies from microfilm. It is equipped with a 11X power lens and a fiche carrier.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 The operating instruction for the R-5157 are covered in the RP405E (Minolta Operators Manual). This manual must remain in close proximity to the R-5157 Reader Printer. If this manual is lost, contact the Supplier for an additional copy.
