

## SERVICE SENTRY AND SAFETY REPORTER

### 1. GENERAL

#### 1.1 Scope of Section

1.11 This section describes and explains the publications known as the Service Sentry and the Safety Reporter.

### 2. PURPOSE

2.1 The Service Sentry is intended to aid the installer in the prevention of service interruptions while the Safety Reporter seeks to prevent personal injuries from occurring while performing job operations. It is the intent that both publications be used as discussion material by Installation Supervisors during job huddles.

### 3. CONTENTS

3.1 These publications consist of timely topics, examples of recent service interruptions or injury reports, questions for discussions and answers to these questions based on handbook procedures.

### 4. DISTRIBUTION

4.1 Both publications are distributed every two months to Installation Area Managers, District Managers, Area Supervisors, Installation Engineering Department Chiefs, Department Chiefs Technical Coordination and Job Supervisors.
