1. GENERAL

1.1 This section describes PBS drawings. It informs the installer as to under what conditions they will be issued, and also informs him as to the means that will be employed to notify him of their existence and how they will be sent to him.

2. DESCRIPTION

2.1 A PBS Drawing is a paper print on which "Markings" or "Changes" stand out in contrast to all other information.

2.2 The PBS drawing may be identified by the letter "W" appended to the drawing number in the Title Box and the job order number listed directly beneath the drawing number. For example:

T-9762-5860W
57342-EG

3. APPLICATION

3.1 Since the selection of drawings for PBS application cannot be governed by any set of criteria the degree of complexity of change will determine if a PBS Copy will be required for a given change.

3.2 A consensus has established that PBS Drawings will be provided for changes to office plan type drawings (floor and cable plans, frame and aisle lighting, selector frames and assignment charts for Dial Systems) and for those other drawing changes for which an "N" drawing is normally employed.

3.3 PBS copies will never be provided on

- (a) Original issues.
- (b) Voided drawings.
- (c) Additions only.

3.4 Dependent upon the complexity of change, all other drawings are candidates for this routine. Only one PBS application per drawing per order will however be provided.

4. NOTIFICATION AND DISTRIBUTION

4.1 When a PBS drawing is prepared on a given order it will be listed under "Installers Reference Papers" in the effected specification. Distribution of the PBS copy will be at the same time and in the same manner as the regular office drawings.
