OVER-ALL INSPECTION OF CONDITION AND PERFORMANCE

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 155-199-902PT, Issue F.

1.002 It is issued to add information on field responsibilities for portable engine generators.

7. RESPONSIBILITIES AND LOCATION OF PORTABLE ENGINE GENERATOR SETS

The following changes apply to Part 7 of the section:

- Part 7 title — revised
- 7.01 renumbered to 7.03
- 7.01 and 7.02 — added

7.01 The District Manager is responsible for all portable engine generator sets stored or brought into the district.

7.02 Responsibilities include the following items:

- (a) Generator sets are to be properly stored, maintained, fueled, equipped, and ready for use or relocation at all times.
- (b) Sets brought into or relocated within the district should be promptly and satisfactorily returned to their designated storage location.
- (c) *All changes* of location or operational status of portable emergency equipment are to be reported to the Power Maintenance Staff.
- (d) Routine exercise runs are to be made in accordance with the main section.
- (e) All personnel involved in the operation and maintenance of portable emergency equipment must be properly trained.

7.03 Tables A through E are provided to show the location where the sets are stored.
