the preceding table of contents. Test classification and frequency of periodic routine are also provided.

**12.02** This is the first issuance of the "reformatted ETL" which provides better organization of the various tests. The "reformatted ETLs" replace the ETLs previously provided for this equipment.

**12.03** Comments on this section should be made by following the instructions in Bell System Practices (BSP), Section 000-010-015.

**12.04** Routine test information is arranged in the following order from left to right: Section number, issue/addendum, test letter or paragraph number, test title, test class, frequency, and the last space is for a locally assigned job number.

**12.05** Section 010-300-011 provides Equipment Test List instructions.
