TEST EDITOR PROGRAM
CENTRALIZED AUTOMATIC REPORTING ON TRUNKS (CAROT)

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 190-102-205, Issue 1. Place this pink sheet ahead of Page 1 at the section.

1.002 This addendum is being issued to delete all references to the **HELP** command and to revise information concerning the **SAVE** command. This addendum does not affect the Equipment Test List.

2. CHANGES TO SECTION

2.001 On Page 11, delete the **HELP Command, Abbreviation H** paragraph.

2.002 On Page 15, under **SAVE Command, Abbreviation S** heading, revise the comments subparagraph to read as follows:

Comments: *n1* and *n2* specify the range of lines in the work-space file to be saved in the specified file. Character strings should **not** be used for variables *n1* and *n2*. If *n1* and *n2* are not given, all lines of the work-space file will be saved. If only *n1* is given, only that line will be saved. On the first save to a particular file, the

file will be opened. Subsequent saves to the same file will overwrite that file. When the editor is terminated, an end-of-file mark is written at the end of the file. Attempts to save data in an already existing file which was not created during the current run of the editor will cause an error message. If it is desired to overwrite a previously used file, first purge the old file using the **PURGE** command.

The optional update flag, **UP**, indicates that the file should be used as input data for the next run of the update cycle. The data will only be used for one update, but the file will not be purged. This will allow the user to make changes to the file using the editor and to use the new data for the next update. This feature was incorporated for instances in which there was an error in the data which caused the update data to be rejected. The maximum number of files which can be flagged for update is 31. Any attempt to set more than 31 files will result in an error 12 (cannot set update flag) occurring.

2.003 On Page 39, paragraph 5.01, delete the **HELP** *<mnemonic>* , [*device*] entry (ninth entry from the top).
