



302-Type Connectors Description, Use, Installation, and Repair Procedures

1. Overview

- 1.001 This addendum supplements AT&T 201-208-107, Issue 1. Place this pink sheet ahead of Page 1 of the practice.
- 1.002 This addendum is issued to correct and clarify the procedures for removing and installing terminals.

2. Changes

Issue 1 Changes

- 2.001 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.09 with the following:

Using B long-nose pliers, spread the legs on the damaged or broken terminal and remove the terminal from the front side of the connector panel.
- 2.002 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.14 with the following:

Using the fingers, properly orient the new terminal and insert into the same hole from which the old terminal was removed. Push the terminal into the hole as far as possible with the orange stick.
- 2.003 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.17 with the following:

Using B long-nose pliers, carefully spread the barbs of the terminal to lock the terminal in place in the connector panel.
- 2.004 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.20 with the following:

Using the fingers, properly orient the new terminal and insert into the same hole from which the old terminal was removed. Push the terminal into the hole as far as possible with the orange stick.

2.005 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.23 with the following:

Using B long-nose pliers, carefully fold the legs or tangs of the terminal to lock the terminal in place around the ground rod.

2.006 On Page 17, replace paragraph 4.25 with the following:

Using the soldering copper, solder the terminal to the ground rod.
