

METHOD OF HANDLING PERMANENT SIGNALS  
STEP-BY-STEP AND COMMUNITY DIAL OFFICES

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements section 226-135-300.

1.002 It is issued to revise paragraph 1.05 and add paragraph 4.15.

The following change applies to Part 1 of the section:

1.05 Time will be saved if arrangements are made with the test center or dial administration to maintain line terminal records so that reports may be made by line terminal numbers rather than by connector terminal numbers.

4. RELEASE OF EQUIPMENT HELD BY PERMANENTS BY USE OF PLUGGING-UP CIRCUITS

Offices Not Equipped With Plugging Up Circuits

4.15 When it is necessary to give trouble intercepting service to special service lines, such as police, fire, large PBX, etc., the plant service center will notify the central office forces to intercept lines on the IDF. Connect the telephone numbers involved to "Operator Intercept". The plant service center will then notify the manuscript bureau in the traffic department. When service is restored to normal the plant service center will notify the central office to discontinue intercept service.
