


COMMUNICATION INSTRUCTIONS DEFINITIONS

1. COMMUNICATION INSTRUCTIONS DEFINITIONS

1.01 Communication instructions are concerned with characters (one character is equivalent to 1 byte). These instructions are unique and are primarily designed for interfacing several external devices (for example, terminals) to the Central Control (CC). A parameter table (associated with each device) serves to isolate the devices from the CC. The communication instructions provide the means to manipulate data (load and store) between the devices, the tables, and the CC.
