TERMINATION RESTRICTION

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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Description

- 1.11 This section describes the tests to be performed whenever one or more stations are equipped for Termination Restriction.
- 1.12 This feature restricts a station, so equipped, from receiving calls.

2. RECORDS AND REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Records

- 2.11 Form SD-97-1313 is required for recording the results of this test.

3. TEST EQUIPMENT

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4. PROCEDURE4.1 Test Procedure

- 4.101 From the Class of Service Assignments section of the Customer Order Document determine which Class's of Service have Termination Restriction
- 4.102 From the Station Line Assignments section of the Customer Order Document choose a station with Class of Service that includes Termination Restriction.
- 4.103 Utilizing the 249A Adapter, connect the handset to a test line, at a circuit pack, associated with a station that does not have Termination Restriction.
- 4.104 Go off-hook with the handset, verify dial tone, and then dial the access code associated with a line that has Termination Restriction (see Step 4.102). Verify:
- a) That the handset receives intercept tone.
- 4.105 Go on-hook with the handset and remove the handset and 249A Adapter from the circuit pack test line.
- 4.106 Determine if the system is equipped with DID trunks, if it is go to the next step else go to Step 4.110
- 4.107 From the System and Feature Summary section of the Customer Order Document determine if the DID intercept treatment is optioned for intercept tone or routing to the attendant.
- 4.108 Initiate a DID call to the station with Termination Restriction. Verify:
- a) That the calling party either receives intercept tone or is routed to the attendant as determined in Step 4.107.
- 4.109 Terminate the DID call.
- 4.110 This completes the testing of the Termination Restriction feature.
