

**RADIO ADMINISTRATION  
MICROWAVE RADIO  
POINT-TO-POINT FCC COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS**

**1. GENERAL**

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 400-401-000.

1.002 It is issued to:

- (a) Authorize the use of Forms P 3082, P 3093 and P 3094 in lieu of Forms E 4973 and FCC Form 452-C for transmitter identification
- (b) Delete Form E 4973 (Fig. 11)

- Form P 3094 (Exhibit 1) for equipment licensed to Nevada Bell

5.02.2 **Ordering Information:** The forms are available at Western Electric. Consult the catalog for correct ordering information.

**Use and Posting of Forms**

5.02.3 All forms are to be used the same way, in lieu of the 452C form. They are for application on equipment licensed under the FCC Rules, Sections 5, 21, 81, 83, 89, and 91.

**5. OPERATIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE EQUIPMENT**

The following changes apply to Part 5 of the section:

- (f) Domestic Public Land Radio Mobile or Base Stations . . . . . Section 21.202
- (g) Other Fixed Stations . . . . . Section 21.202

**Transmitter Identification**

5.02 It is an FCC requirement that when a transmitter is installed, a Transmitter Identification Card (FCC Form 452-C) or equivalent must be properly completed and attached to the transmitter in a place readily visible for inspection (Fig. 1 of Task 6A). Forms P 3082, P 3093 and P 3094 should be used in lieu of FCC Form 452-C.

5.02.4 Place the identification form on a clean surface so it is clearly visible for inspection.

5.02.1 The back sides of the forms are pressure-sensitive for adhering to hard, clean surfaces. The forms are used as follows:

Specific cases are:

- Form P 3082 (Exhibit 2) for equipment licensed to PT&T
- Form P 3093 (Exhibit 3) for equipment licensed to AT&T

- (a) *For mobile control units, apply to the control unit, or if not practical, immediately adjacent to it. It must be readily visible for inspection. For uniformity, apply labels to the control equipment for stations licensed under Section 89 as well as Sections 91 and 21 of the FCC Rules.*

- (b) *For temporary radio services and microwave radio*, apply to the face of the control equipment so it is readily visible for inspection. Do not apply the form under covers. If a transmitter is operated under more than one license, refer to the FCC Plant Compliance Coordinator for specific instructions.
- (c) *For TD-2 radio*, apply the form to the back panel to the right of AMP 1 and opposite the 1303 filter.
- (d) *For TD-3 Radio System*, place the form immediately to the right of the type acceptance tag.
- (e) *For TD3A Radio System*, place the form immediately below the type acceptance tag.
- (f) *For TH3 Radio Systems*, place the form on the back plate below the 6 GHz transmitter multiplier.
- (g) *For TJ radio*, place the form on the lower half of the transmitter klystron housing.
- (h) *For TL or TM radio*, place the form on the lower left corner of the klystron housing.
- (i) *For TH-1 Radio System*, place the form on the BB-RAD-TRS Bay, beside the HV-SW and above the RF pwr out meter.
- (j) *For Lenkurt 75A System*, place the form on the meter control panel above the indicating meter.
- (k) *For Lenkurt 76A System*, place the form on transmitter shelf on right hand door above the hazardous voltage decal.
- (l) *For Collins MW 109B*, place the form on the transmitter control unit, on the blank panel to the right of the TX AFC unit.

(m) *For Collins MW 109E*, place the form on the TWT shelf on the base tray assembly "781-3661-001" to the right side of TWT unit.

(n) *For other fixed station, mobile base station or Rural Radio service*, apply to the face of equipment so that it is readily available for inspection.

*Note:* In case of question, refer matter to the Plant Compliance Coordinator.

**ENTRIES ON FORMS**

**5.02.5** Enter the call sign that appears on the station license or authorization. This may be typed or written with ballpoint pen.

**5.02.6** The operator shall see that the correct form is attached to the equipment (see 5.02.1). Do not attach forms to company-owned government system equipment.

**9. PORTABLE MICROWAVE REPEATERS (PMRs)**

The following change applies to Part 9 of the section:

- 9.03 — revised

**Identification of PMRs**


**9.03** It is an FCC requirement that each PMR must have a readily visible and executed transmitter identification card affixed to the unit. Use either Form P 3092, P 3093 or P 3094 as appropriate.
