FCC COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 400-401-000, Issue 2. Place this pink sheet ahead of Page 1 of the section.

1.002 This addendum is issued for the following reasons:

- (a) To add information regarding mobile television pickup to paragraphs 10.05, 10.06, 10.07, and new 10.09 and to the cross-reference index in Part 17 of this section
- (b) To delete the note at the end of paragraph 10.05
- (c) To delete paragraphs 10.08 and 10.09
- (d) To renumber paragraphs 10.10 and 10.11 to 10.08 and 10.09, respectively
- (e) To add a note to Fig. 19.

2. CHANGES TO SECTION

2.001 On Page 43, change paragraph 10.05 as follows:

Notification Requirement for Temporary Fixed and Mobile Television Pickup Stations

10.05 When service is to be provided under a temporary fixed (TF) or a mobile television

pickup (MTV-PU) license (see paragraphs 10.03 and 10.04, respectively), notification (see paragraph 10.06) of each usage must be given to the FCC in Washington, D.C., and to the FCC's EIC of the involved radio district. Notification may be sent by letter, facsimile, or Western Union telegraph at least 5 days prior to the installation of facilities. Less than 5 days' notice may be given where circumstances beyond the control of the licensee dictate a shorter notice. After-the-fact notification to the FCC in Washington, D.C., is acceptable when short lead times associated with service orders do not permit advance notification. However, the appropriate EIC should be advised of the proposed operation by telephone when there is not enough time for advance written notification. Verbal notifications should be followed by the transmittal of a confirming letter.

2.002 On Page 43, delete the note at the end of paragraph 10.05.

2.003 On Page 43, change paragraph 10.06 as follows:

10.06 Notifications covering TF and MTV-PU operation should include the following information:

- (a) Call sign of appropriate license
- (b) through (g)—unchanged

Not for use or disclosure outside the
Bell System except under written agreement

Figure 19 is an example of a TF notification. The same format should be used for MTV-PU notifications.

Note 1: Where TF or MTV-PU operation is to be conducted in excess of 90 days, the notification provided must also include an explanation as to why an application should not be made for a regular authorization.

Note 2: Operation of stations involving frequency bands shared by the Communication—Satellite Service within the coordination distance contour of (1) an existing earth station or (2) a proposed earth station for which an application is on file with the FCC requires compliance with § 21.706(e) of the FCC's Rules. In such cases, the notification provided to the FCC and EIC must include a statement regarding compliance with FCC 21.706(e).

Note 3: The antenna structure height employed must not exceed the criteria of § 17.7 (see Section 400-100-003) of the FCC's Rules unless, for each case, FCC authorization is obtained prior to erection of the structure.

2.004 On Page 44, change paragraph 10.07 as follows:

Notification Requirement for Remotely Controlled Mobile Television Pickup Station

10.07 The notification requirements described in paragraphs 10.05 and 10.06 also apply to remotely controlled mobile television pickup operation except that (1) the FCC's EIC of the involved radio district must be notified prior to such operation and (2) the notification must include the specific location from which the transmitter is to be controlled.

Note: Control point requirements are specified in FCC 21.118(c) and (f), and licensed operator requirements for remote control operation of mobile TV pickup stations are included in FCC 21.205(j).

2.005 On Page 44, delete paragraphs 10.08 and 10.09 and Notes 1 and 2.

2.006 On Page 44, renumber paragraph 10.10 to 10.08.

2.007 On Page 44, renumber paragraph 10.11 to 10.09 and change the paragraph as follows:

Temporary Fixed and Mobile Television Pickup Stations Licensed as Permanent

10.09 When service will be provided for longer than 6 months, TF and MTV-PU stations must be licensed as permanent. To maintain continuity of service in such cases, construction permit and license applications (FCC Forms 435 and 436, respectively) must be simultaneously filed at least 30 days prior to expiration of the 6-month operational period.

2.008 On Page 45/46, add the following note at the lower left of Fig. 19:

Note: The above format is also applicable to notifications covering MTV-PU operation.

2.009 On Page 61, replace the compliance items "Temporary Fixed (TF) Stations" and "Mobile Television Pickup (MTV Pickup) Stations" and their practice references with the following listing:
