4. Federal Register

Published 5 days a week, except holidays. Contains proposed and adopted Rule making (amendments), hearing orders, miscellaneous notices, and common carrier applications accepted for filing. Also contains similar information on many other government agencies. Yearly subscription.

5. Annual Report of the FCC

Report of fiscal year's activity to Congress. Also contains a listing of printed publications and much data.

6. Price Lists No. 36, No. 79, and No. 82 (free)

Categorized publications available and their cost.

7. FCC Reports

Weekly pamphlets with decisions, reports, public notices, and other documents. Yearly subscription or single report basis.

8. Airport Directory of the Airman's Information Manual

Provides airport locations, elevations, runway lengths, etc.

Describes the FAA standards and establishes methods, procedures, and equipment types as official FAA policy.

2. Advisory Circular 70/7460, Proposed Construction or Alteration of Objects That May Affect the Navigable Airspace (free)

Provides diagrams of conditions requiring FAA notification.

Contract Services

The FCC does not maintain mailing lists or subscription service for its publications or reports. Those documents not available through the FCC or the Government Printing Office may be obtained through the services of a firm specializing in gathering and compiling such information. Various subscription services are available, depending on the user's interest. An account may be established with most contractors so that subscriptions do not lapse inadvertently, or services may be requested on demand without delay.
