

JACKS AND PLUGS

IDENTIFICATION AND SERVICE

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 461-630-100, Issue 9. Place this pink sheet ahead of Page 1 of the section.

1.002 This addendum is issued:

- To provide information on the 1A converter
- To provide information on the 281A adapter.

1.003 Issue 1 of this addendum was issued for the following reasons:

- To provide information on the 267A adapter
- To add the C weatherproof cord to the Ordering Guide.

2. CHANGES TO SECTION

ISSUE 1 CHANGES

2.001 On Page 1, add the following figure numbers and titles to paragraph 2.04(a) *Illustration Index*:

Fig. 13.1—267A Adapter
Fig. 13.2—Schematic Diagram, 267A Adapter




Fig. 13.2—Schematic Diagram, 267A Adapter




Fig. 13.1—267A Adapter (Plugged Into 625B Connecting Block)

2.002 Add Fig. 13.1 and 13.2.

2.003 On Page 3, add the following items to the Ordering Guide in the proper alphabetical order.

- Adapter, 267A
- Cord, Weatherproof, C

2.004 On Page 4, change the second bullet under Application to read as follows:

- Fig. 12, 13, and 13.1 show adapters used with plug-ended mounting cords.

2.005 On Page 31, add the following subparagraph and Caution after 4.18(b):

- (c) The 267A adapter (Fig. 13.1) consists of two modular line cord type jacks connected to a single modular line cord type plug. It can be mounted piggy-back on a 224A or 225A adapter or plugged directly into an existing modular jack.

Caution: *Because of the possibility of installing more than one transformer on the same inside wiring pair, the 267A adapter should not be used to connect dial illumination transformers to modular systems.*

ISSUE 2 CHANGES

2.006 On Page 1, add the following figure numbers and titles to paragraph 2.04(a):

Fig. 13.3—1A Converter
Fig. 13.4—281A Adapter

2.007 On Page 1, after the second bullet in paragraph 2.03, add the following paragraphs:





Fig. 13.3—1A Converter

The 1A converter (Fig. 13.3) is used to convert the 404B (MD), 493A (MD), 497A (MD), 548A and 549A jacks (4-pin jacks) to the modular system. The 1A converter, when plugged into a 4-pin jack, is designed to be nonremovable.




Fig. 13.4—281A Adapter

The 281A adapter (Fig. 13.4) is used to plug into the 623-type line cord jack in the base of the PRINCESS® telephone. This adapter allows the installation of dial illumination

transformers without connecting the power to the inside station wiring.

2.008 On Page 3, add the following items to the *Ordering Guide* in alphabetical order:

- Converter, 1A
- Adapter, 281A

2.009 On Page 4, change the second bullet under *Application* to read as follows:

- Fig. 12, 13, 13.1, 13.3, and 13.4 show adapters used with plug-ended mounting cords.

2.010 Add Fig. 13.3 and 13.4.

281A ADAPTER
