

## HANDSETS

### G1,G2,G3,G4, AND G5 TYPES

#### IDENTIFICATION, MAINTENANCE, AND SCHEMATICS

##### 1. General

1.01 This addendum supplements Section 501-210-102. It is re-issued to add Paragraph 1.02, 1.03, 4.02, and to change Paragraph 3.04 and add information to 2.22.

1.02 The "Push-To-Listen" features are only to be provided on sets of the 500, 600 or 700 type (key or non-key). In the event this service is required where there is a 300 or 400 type telephone set using an F-type handset, it is recommended the set be replaced with the appropriate 500, 600 or 700 type.

##### 2. Identification - G4 Type

2.22 Shoulder Rest Handset-Switchboards-Remove the H4 CJ cord from a G4B-3 handset and replace it with an H4 BL-3 cord e/w 289B plug.

*(Note - The standard length of the handset cord to be used with switchboards is four feet).*

##### 3. Maintenance

3.04 A locking arrangement is available for use with G-type handsets if there is repeated loss of either caps or units. Transmitter and receiver caps on these handsets can be securely locked by applying an adhesive cement, EC-847 (Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Company). Application consists of coating the handle threads from the top to the base over a 1/2 inch length in one place only. The caps are then hand-tightened. The 514B tool is used to remove caps.

4. Connections

4.02 For connections of G5KR handset to 500, 600, or 700 type sets, use Table A and Figure 1 of this addendum.


