CARD DIALER—TELEPHONE SETS
SELECTION

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section is intended for use as an aid in the selection of Card Dialer type telephone sets. Table A lists the available 0- and 1-button codes and Table B multiline 6-button codes. Both rotary and TOUCH-TONE® dial sets are listed.

1.02 This section is reissued to add information on the 660A1M, 662A1M, 2660A1M, and 2662A1M (modular) telephone sets.

1.03 When ordering a particular code, include the set color suffix. Refer to appropriate Reference section for color information.

1.04 Table C lists the appropriate Reference and Service section for complete ordering and connection information. Table D lists key feature options.

1.05 For common installation and maintenance information, refer to Section 502-600-102.
