

## HAND TELEPHONE SETS — 200 SERIES

### LOCAL BATTERY — CONNECTIONS GENERAL

#### 1.00 INTRODUCTION

This section covers general information for the connection of local battery talking—common battery signaling hand telephone sets.

#### 2.00 GENERAL

**2.01** Selection of the proper types of apparatus to be used in combination for a desired service, which will meet transmission zoning requirements, is covered in the sections covering selection of station sets.

**2.02** Specific information for connections and combinations of apparatus and circuit diagrams are covered in subsequent individual sections for each type of hand telephone set.

**2.03** The circuit diagrams in these sections may be associated with the circuit diagram of appropriate subscriber sets to provide complete information for the connection of station apparatus. Circuit diagrams for the subscriber sets are shown on foldout pages in the preceding sections which cover the connections for the specific equipment item.

**2.04** The circuit diagrams for the hand telephone sets show both manual and dial connections; manual connections are shown by broken or dotted lines.

**2.05** Unless the circuit diagram indicates that the hand telephone set must be rewired or modified, it will normally be furnished with connections as shown. Rewired means: changes in the connections must be made; whereas, modified means: replacement of some component part is necessary in addition to possible changes in the connections.
