

HAND TELEPHONE SETS — 212L
LOCAL BATTERY — CONNECTIONS

1.00 INTRODUCTION

This section covers the combination of apparatus, circuit diagram, and connections for the 212-type hand telephone sets for local battery talking—common battery signaling service.

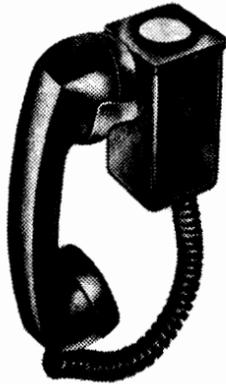


FIG. 1—212L MANUAL

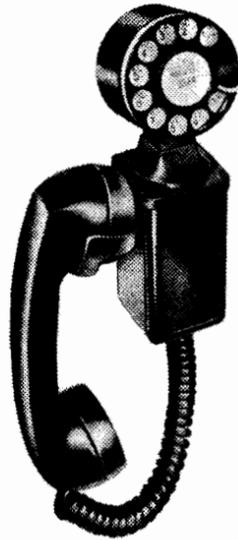


FIG. 2—212L DIAL

Notes

1. Codes listed are for apparatus with black finish. For apparatus finished in other colors, the dash number (-3) is changed to the code number for the particular color.
2. Arranged for but does not come equipped with 61M filter.
3. Provided for dial service only. Dial hand telephone set must be converted to manual when used for manual service.
4. When the handset is equipped with spring cord, the suffix R will be added to the set code. For example, a 212L-3 becomes a 212LR-3.

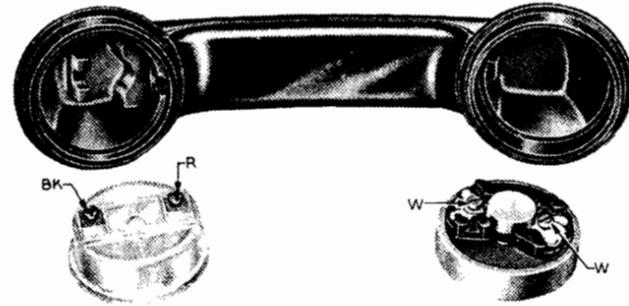


FIG. 3—G1A-3 HANDSET

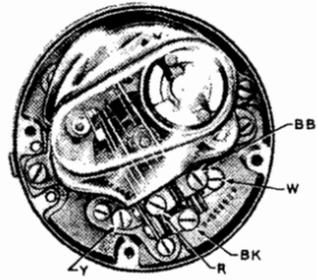


FIG. 4—6A DIAL

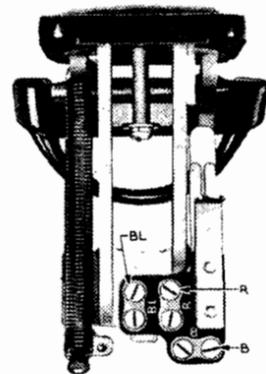
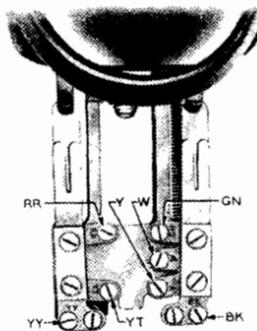
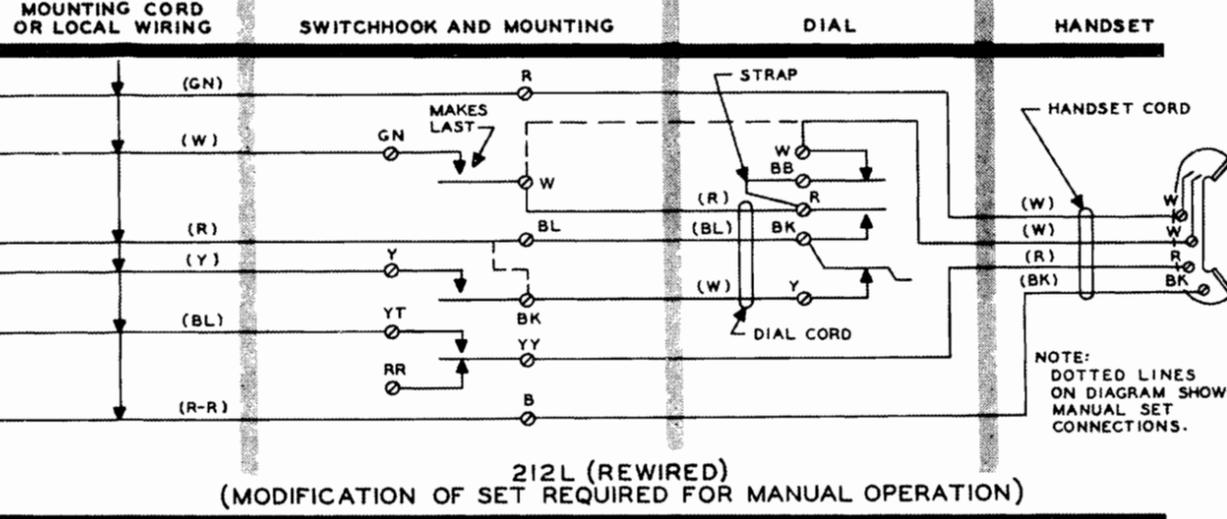


FIG. 5—G7-3 HANDSET MOUNTING

2.00 GENERAL

2.01 The 212-type hand telephone set is furnished for dial service only and must be converted to manual operation when used to provide manual service.

2.02 Conversion to manual operation is accomplished by removing dial, dial mounting, and dial cords, then connecting set as shown in the circuit diagram.

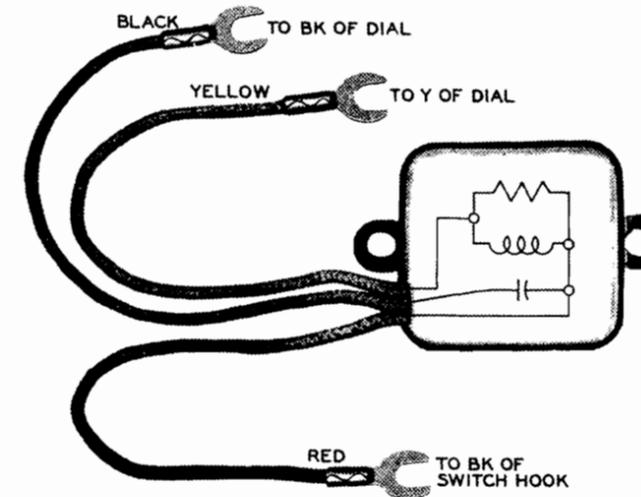


FIG. 6—61M FILTER CONNECTIONS

3.01 When filters are required for radio-frequency suppression, equip the hand telephone sets with 61M filters connected as shown in Fig. 6. Disconnection of dial cord between the Y terminal of dial and the BK terminal of switchhook is required when filter is provided.
