1. GENERAL

- 1.001 This Addendum supplements Section 518-450-102.
- 1.002 This Addendum is issued to provide information for the use of the SAN/BAR 4000F Line Card in the 14A Communication Systems. For detailed information on installation and testing of the SB4000F Line Card, refer to BSP 518-215-905SW.
- 1.003 Issue A of this Addendum was issued to provide a means to activate the customer's equipment when COAM Paging equipment is used with the 14A Communications System. A 22A-49 apparatus unit is used to provide contact closure to COAM Paging equipment.

2.003 On page 24, at the end of paragraph 3.04, add the following information:

. (Qua) Unit, Telephone Key, SB4000F - Issue 6 CO/PBX Line Circuit (order one per line for use in 580A or 580B KSU)

2.004 On page 92, at the end of paragraph 6.04, add the following paragraph:

Option straps should be placed on the SB4000F - Issue 6 KTU, when used with the 14A Communications System to provide short time-out (P), lamp wink on hold (Y); and interrupted audible signal (W).


