Chapter 1: Introduction

Taking a few moments to read this document will help you find and use essential information about the Nortel (Northern Telecom) publications (NTPs) associated with your Meridian Mail system. The *NTP Contents Overview* describes each of the NTPs available with Release 12 of Meridian Mail.

Nortel publications (NTPs) are assigned unique ten-digit identification numbers in the format XXX-YYYY-ZZZ.

The first three digits (XXX, the division number) identify the general product line. For example, 555 is the product code assigned to Office Systems and Services products.

Note: NTPs specifically intended for the Message Services Module (MSM platform) or for Meridian Mail platforms (that is, the Modular Option GP or MSM) connected to a DMS10, DMS100, or SL100 switch, use the 557 division number.

The middle four digits (the layer number) further subdivide the classification into specific product lines. Meridian Mail documents are assigned numbers in the 70x1 layer, where “x” represents the corresponding product line as follows:

- 7001 Meridian Mail documents common to all options
- 7041 Meridian Mail Modular Option documentation
- 7051 Meridian Mail Modular Option GP documentation
- 7061 Meridian Mail Modular Option EC documentation
- 7071 Meridian Mail Card Option documentation
- 7081 Meridian Mail EC11 documentation

Note: NTPs specifically intended for the MSM or for Meridian Mail platforms (that is, the Modular Option GP or MSM) connected to a DMS10, DMS100, or SL100 switch, use the 7001 layer number.

The last three digits (the key number) relate to the content of the NTP. The following conventions are used for Meridian Mail documents:

- 1XX—general-purpose information (for example, 555-7001-100 Messaging Overview)
- 2XX—hardware installation and maintenance, and configuration (for example, 555-7061-250 Modular Option EC Installation and Maintenance Guide)
- 3XX—system software and applications (for example, 555-7001-301 System Administration Guide)
- 5XX—maintenance information (for example, 555-7001-510 Maintenance Messages (SEERs))

Publications are packaged into document suites. A suite can be ordered by contacting your Nortel distributor and providing one of the assembly numbers associated with it. The assembly numbers associated with each suite can be found in Chapter 3.

In the case of MSM documents, inform your distributors that you want all of the NTPs in the MSM 12 runlist. For more information concerning the MSM runlist, refer to Chapter 3 “NTP listings.”

Chapter 2: NTP contents

This chapter describes all of the Nortel publications (NTPs), or documents, in the Meridian Mail library as of Release 12. The documents you order from this library will vary depending on your configuration (that is, hardware platform, administrative type, switch, and features installed on your system).

The contents of each document are described in numerical sequence based on the following category headings:

- ***Independent documents*** These are documents which can be used regardless of your configuration.
- ***Planning, installation, and maintenance documents*** These are documents which assist in the planning, installation, and maintenance of your selected Meridian Mail hardware platform.
- ***Administration documents*** These are documents used to administer and maintain the Meridian Mail system. They are dependent on either your administrative type or hardware platform.
- ***Application- or feature-specific documents*** These are documents used to install, maintain, or administer an optional Meridian Mail feature (such as Outcalling) or application (such as Meridian ACCESS). These documents are independent of system configuration unless otherwise indicated.
- ***MSM-specific documents*** These are documents specifically related to supporting Meridian Mail on the Message Services Module (MSM) platform.

Refer to Chapter 3 “NTP listings,” for information on how these documents can be ordered to create a reference library tailored to meet your specific needs.

Independent documentation

These are all-purpose generic documents that are used to support Meridian Mail Release 12. Customers can order any one of these documents regardless of the hardware platform, system configuration, or switch type they are using.

NTP Contents Overview (NTP 555-7001-000)

The *NTP Contents Overview* describes each of the Meridian Mail installation, maintenance, and administration NTPs and feature manuals.

This guide is intended for those individuals responsible for, or who assist in, ordering Meridian Mail documentation.

Messaging Overview (NTP 555-7001-100)

The *Messaging Overview* describes the features and capabilities of the Meridian Mail Release 12 system and provides an overview of the supported hardware platforms and peripherals.

This guide is intended for anyone who wants a general understanding of the Meridian Mail hardware and system, and their capabilities and limitations.

System Installation and Modification Guide (NTP 555-7001-215)

The *System Installation and Modification Guide* describes the functions available on the Install/data tape (such as Meridian Mail software installation and upgrade) and the comprehensive upgrade option which bundles together previous options (such as storage and language expansion, and hardware modifications).

This guide is intended for administrators or service technicians who are familiar with Meridian Mail operation and maintenance procedures.

System Administration Tools (NTP 555-7001-305)

The *System Administration Tools* guide describes how to use the Meridian Mail Tools interface for advanced troubleshooting and configuration functions.

Maintenance Messages (SEERs)(NTP 555-7001-510)

This guide lists System Error and Event Reports (SEERs). SEER information helps you to isolate and fix system problems.

Planning, installation, and maintenance documents

The documents listed here are used to plan, install, and maintain an operational Meridian Mail Release 12 system; however, their applicability will vary depending on the customer's hardware platform.

Customers should review these documents carefully and determine which ones best suit their needs.

Site and Installation Planning

The *Site and Installation Planning* or the *Planning and Engineering* guides assist in selecting and planning the Meridian Mail hardware installation site, and include the following information:

- determining system size
- developing the site
- preparing for Meridian Mail hardware installation
- planning spares

Networking Planning Guide (NTP 555-7001-241)

The *Networking Planning Guide* provides descriptive information and instruction on deciding which networking features a customer should implement.

It provides planning information for the following Meridian Mail networking features:

- Meridian Mail Networking (which includes Meridian Networking and Enterprise Networking)
- AMIS Networking
- Virtual Node AMIS Networking
- Network Message Service (NMS)

This guide is written primarily for sales and planning engineers, but can also be used by customers who are implementing a networking feature.

Installation and Maintenance

The *Installation and Maintenance* guides provide the procedures and related information necessary to install an operational Meridian Mail system running Release 12.

The installation section contains procedures for the following:

- unpacking a shelf or cabinet, and disk unit
- installing Meridian Mail hardware
- installing peripheral equipment (such as modems and terminals)
- installing either the Meridian Link (AML/DIAL link) between the Meridian Mail system and the Meridian 1 Private Branch Exchange (PBX) or the SMDI link between the Meridian Mail system and the DMS-SL-100 or Connections switch
- configuring the Meridian 1 or PBX on a DMS-SL-100 or Connections switch

The maintenance section describes hardware maintenance and troubleshooting procedures for

- the administrator's terminal and printer
- Meridian Mail applicable hardware system
- AML/DIAL link for Meridian Mail systems connected to a Meridian 1
- SMDI link for Meridian Mail systems connected to a DMS-SL-100 or Connections switch

Note: Troubleshooting procedures for Meridian Link are not described in the Modular Option GP systems NTP.

System Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-301)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *single-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on a Meridian 1 platform. (These platforms include the Modular Option, Modular Option EC, Card Option, and EC11.)

This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

System Administration Guide for Multi-Customer Systems (NTP 555-7001-302)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *multi-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on a Meridian 1 platform. (These platforms include the Modular Option, Modular Option EC, Card Option, and EC11.) This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

In a multi-customer environment, many of the parameters you will be configuring are system wide and apply to all customers. In other instances, you will have to select each customer group and configure parameters or services specific to each customer.

System Administration Guide (NTP 555-7051-307)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *single-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on a Modular Option GP platform.

This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

System Administration Guide for Multi-Customer Systems (NTP 555-7051-308)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *multi-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on a Modular Option GP platform. This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

In a multi-customer environment, many of the parameters you will be configuring are system wide and apply to all customers. In other instances, you will have to select each customer group and configure parameters or services specific to each customer.

Application- or feature-specific documents

The documents listed below are used to install, maintain, or administer optional Meridian Mail features (such as networking, Outcalling, Fax on Demand) or applications (such as Meridian ACCESS).

These documents are independent of hardware platform, system configuration, or switch type unless otherwise indicated.

Voicebridge Installation Procedures for AT&T Switches

Voicebridge Installation Procedures for AT&T Switches describes the procedures for installing the Voicebridge link between an AT&T PBX and Nortel's Meridian Mail.

Note: Voicebridge for AT&T switches can be linked to Modular Option GP and MSM systems.

Voicebridge Installation Procedures for AT&T Switches has not been reissued since Meridian Mail Release 9 (MM9). If you wish to order the MM9 document, use either the P0 number (P0746527) or the document's NTP number (555-7001-216).

Voicebridge Installation Procedures for ROLM Switches

Voicebridge Installation Procedures for ROLM Switches describes the procedures for installing the Voicebridge link between a ROLM PBX and Nortel's Meridian Mail.

Note: Voicebridge for ROLM switches can be linked to Modular Option GP and MSM systems.

The *Voicebridge Installation Procedures for ROLM Switches* has not been reissued since MM9. If you wish to order the MM9 document, use either the P0 number (P0746528) or the document's NTP number (555-7001-217).

HVS Implementation Guide (NTP 555-7001-221)

This guide provides the prospective user of Hospitality Voice Services (HVS) with an effective planning tool. The guide helps the user focus attention on important considerations that should be taken into account when planning for the implementation of HVS.

HVS GAC Guide/Guest Voice Messaging Reference Guide (NTP 555-7001-222)

This guide describes the Guest Administration Console functions for the HVS system administrator, and the Voice Messaging features available to guests using an HVS system.

AMIS Networking Installation and Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-242)

The *AMIS Networking Installation and Administration Guide* explains how to configure the AMIS Networking feature of Meridian Mail.

This guide is written for both switch and Meridian Mail administrators.

Network Message Service Installation and Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-243)

The *Network Message Service Installation and Administration Guide*

- explains how to configure the Network Message Service feature on Meridian Mail (NMS-MM)
- provides some limited information about how to implement the Network Message Service feature on the Meridian 1 (NMS-MC)

This guide is written for both switch and Meridian Mail administrators.

Network Message Service is a feature that permits the Meridian Mail system to act as a voice messaging service for a network of Meridian 1 switches.

Meridian Networking Installation and Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-244)

The *Meridian Networking Installation and Administration Guide* explains how to install hardware for Meridian Networking, and how to configure this feature.

Virtual Node AMIS Networking Installation and Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-245)

The *Virtual Node AMIS Networking Installation and Administration Guide* explains how to use certain aspects of AMIS Networking.

This guide is written for both switch and Meridian Mail administrators.

Virtual Node AMIS is actually a combination of Meridian Mail Networking and AMIS Networking. Virtual Node AMIS provides the ability to define local and remote sites which are using the AMIS-A protocol.

Enterprise Networking Installation and Administration Guide (NTP 555-7001-246)

The *Enterprise Networking Installation and Administration Guide* explains how to configure the Enterprise Networking feature on Meridian Mail.

This guide is written for both switch and Meridian Mail administrators.

Enterprise Networking is a new feature in Meridian Mail 12. It provides all of the functionality of Meridian Networking but without modems.

Outcalling Application Guide (NTP 555-7001-320)

The *Outcalling Application Guide* describes how to plan, implement, and configure outcalling. The outcalling service includes two features: remote notification and delivery to nonusers.

Note: The Meridian Mail 12 release of the *Outcalling Application Guide* consolidates previous releases of the following NTPs:

- *Outcalling Application Guide* (NTP 555-7001-320) for single-customer Meridian 1 systems
- *Outcalling Application Guide for Multi-Customer Systems* (NTP 555-7001-321) for multi-customer Meridian 1 systems
- *Outcalling Application Guide* (NTP 555-7001-322) for single-customer DMS systems
- *Outcalling Application Guide for Multi-Customer Systems* (NTP 555-7001-323) for multi-customer DMS systems

Voice Services Application Guide (NTP 555-7001-325)

The *Voice Services Application Guide* describes how to plan, implement, configure, maintain, and use the following voice services:

- voice menus

- voice forms
- announcements
- thru-dial services
- time-of-day controllers

Note: This Meridian Mail 12 release of the *Voice Services Application Guide* consolidates previous releases of the following NTPs:

- *Voice Menus Application Guide* (NTP 555-7001-325)
- *Voice Forms Application Guide* (NTP 555-7001-326)

This document also describes how to incorporate services such as fax items if they are installed features. Furthermore, it provides instructions on how to create different types of automated attendants and information services using these services as building blocks.

Fax on Demand Application Guide (NTP 555-7001-327)

The *Fax on Demand Application Guide* describes how to plan and configure fax items, stand-alone fax information services, and the Fax Item Maintenance service. The guide also discusses monitoring of fax services using operational measurement reports.

This guide is written for both switch and Meridian Mail administrators.

Meridian Mail ACCESS Developer's Reference Manual

The *Meridian Mail ACCESS Developer's Reference Manual* has not been reissued since Meridian Mail Release 10 (MM10). If you wish to order this manual, use either one of the following assembly numbers: A0639711 or NT6R88AA.

MSM Product Guide (NTP 557-7001-010)

The *MSM Product Guide* describes the features and capabilities of the Meridian Mail Release 12 system on the Meridian Mail MSM.

This guide is intended for anyone who wants a general understanding of the Meridian Mail MSM hardware and system, and their capabilities and limitations.

MSM Planning and Engineering Guide (NTP 557-7001-100)

The *MSM Planning and Engineering Guide* provides information on assessing the hardware, software, and site requirements for your system.

This document is intended for personnel involved in determining the engineering requirements for setting up Meridian Mail on the Message Services Module (MSM) or who will be involved in the installation of the Meridian Mail MSM.

Note: The MSM Planning and Engineering Guide should be used only for central premises equipment (CPE) markets. For central office (CO) markets, the MSM Installation Methods (IMs) should be used.

System Administration Guide (NTP 557-7001-301)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *single-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on a Message Services Module (MSM) platform.

This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

System Administration Guide for Multi-Customer Systems (NTP 557-7001-302)

This system administration guide provides the procedures and related information necessary to administer a *multi-customer* Meridian Mail Release 12 system operating on an MSM platform. This guide includes procedures for the initial setup of your system, its daily operation, and its routine maintenance.

In a multi-customer environment, many of the parameters you will be configuring are system wide and apply to all customers. In other instances, you will have to select each customer group and configure parameters or services specific to each customer.

MSM Translations Guide (NTP 557-7001-310)

The *MSM Translations Guide* contains procedures for datafilling the DMS/SL100 host so it can interact with the Meridian Mail system. The guide is also used for datafilling line features so a user can be provided with voice mail service.

It is intended for personnel involved in the planning and administration of a Meridian Mail system connected to an SL-100 host or DMS-100 Centrex switch.

MSM Maintenance and Card Replacement Procedures (NTP 557-7001-502)

MSM Maintenance and Card Replacement Procedures provides the procedures and related information necessary to maintain an operational Message Services Module (MSM) system. In addition, this NTP describes how to replace each of the cards in the MSM.
