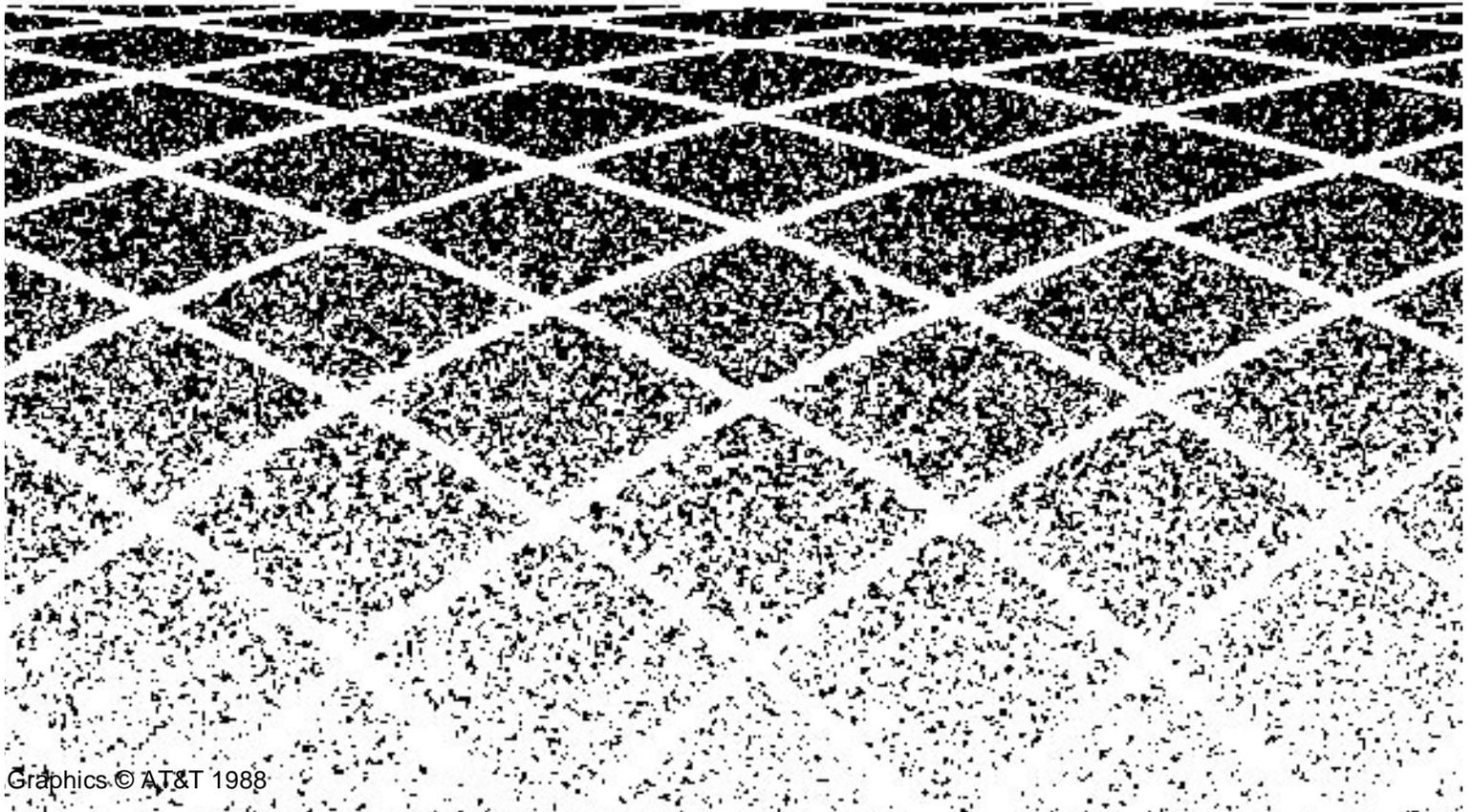

Provides a guide to the ORACLE Precompilers and shows how to develop applications that use SQL to access and manipulate ORACLE data. It is intended primarily for programmers, but may also be useful to systems analysts and project managers.
