

DATA SETS 108D- AND 108E-TYPES
SINGLE PRIVATE LINE STATION ARRANGEMENT
USING DATA AUXILIARY SET 820D
INSTALLATION

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements Section 591-028-201, Issue 1.

1.002 This addendum is issued to provide information pertaining to the use of DAS 830C with the DAS 820D-type.

2. CHANGES TO SECTION

2.001 On Page 1, add paragraph 1.03.1 as follows:

1.03.1 The DAS 820D-type (equipped for EIA interface) can be used with a DAS 830C to provide the station TTY or CPT with a 3- or 4-wire, 20-mA neutral current interface. This interface conforms to the requirements of the technical references entitled 30-Baud Private Line Channels Interface Specifications and 45-, 55-, and 75-Baud Private Line Channels Interface Specifications.

Note: The AR17 CP current interface does not conform to any technical reference interface specification.

2.002 On Page 1, paragraph 1.04, change the last sentence to read as follows: For installation

of DAS 820D-L1 in a model 37 TTY, DAS 820D-L1A in a model 33 or 35 TTY, or DAS 830C with the DAS 820D-type, refer to the sections listed in 6.01.

2.003 On Page 3, Table B, add a note as follows:

Note: When used with DAS 830C, AR17 CP must be equipped with option W (EIA interface).

2.004 On Page 5, revise paragraph 4.03 as follows:

4.03 The customer interface or DAS 830C connections are made through connector J3 located on the rear of DAS 820D. Ensure that the customer-provided interface cord or DAS 830C EIA cord will reach the desired location of the DAS 820D. Do not connect the customer-provided or DAS 830C interface cord to the DAS 820D until option selection and data set adjustments have been completed.

2.005 On Page 5, at the end of paragraph 6.01, add the following:
