

## DATA AUXILIARY SET 804J-TYPE IDENTIFICATION

### 1. GENERAL

**1.01** This section identifies Data Auxiliary Set (DAS) 804J-type used with Data Set 103E-type multiple data station arrangements (103E Data Station) for providing DATA-PHONE<sup>®</sup> service.






Fig. 2—Data Auxiliary Set 804J4, Front View

**1.02** This section is reissued to correct the key designations shown by Fig. 2.

**1.03** DAS 804J-type provides the keys and lamps required for selecting, controlling, and monitoring up to 40 Data Sets 103E-type installed on customer premises and housed in a KS-20093 type cabinet (Fig. 1). In addition to the keys, lamps, and a buzzer, DAS 804J-type is equipped with a dial, network, handset with cord reel, and a ringer to enable the DAS 804J-type to function properly as a telephone set.

**1.04** Four types of DAS 804J-type are available. DAS 804J1 and 804J3 are furnished with a rotary (9C-58) dial while DAS 804J2 and 804J4 are furnished with a TOUCH-TONE<sup>®</sup> (35A3A) dial. In addition, DAS 804J3 and 804J4 are equipped with a DIAL TONE key (W option) in the *action field* for manual origination of telephone calls on ground-start lines. Other than the differences mentioned above, all other provided apparatus is the same for all four types.

**1.05** DAS 804J-type (Fig. 2) is a panel-type data auxiliary set which measures 10-1/2 inches wide, 35 inches high, 6-1/2 inches deep, and weighs approximately 27 pounds. The panel is burnished stainless steel and the handset is furnished in white.

**1.06** Detailed operating instructions and control features for DAS 804J-type are covered in the sections entitled Data Set 103E-Type Multiple Data Station Using KS-20093 Cabinets (591-025-ZZ1) and CD- and SD-1D125-01. Description of the complete system, of which DAS 804J-type is a component, is covered in CD- and SD-1D106-01.



**Fig. 1—Data Auxiliary Set 804J-Type Installed in a KS-20093 Cabinet**
