

URGENT INFORMATION SUPPLEMENT

DISPOSITION OF CURRENT SUPPLY LEADS
AND APPLICATION OF FUSES

1. GENERAL

1.1 The purpose of this UIS is to clarify the handling of "WT" leads at unequipped circuit locations where the current supply leads, furnished in switchboard cable, terminates on previously provided apparatus (partially unequipped).

2. INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Revise Paragraph 2.12 to read as follows:

2.12 Where current supply leads are furnished in a switchboard cable to a Fuse Bay (FB) or Power, Ring and Tone Distribution (PRTD) Frame, and the apparatus at the equipment end is either unequipped or partially unequipped, the current supply leads shall be treated in the following manner;

2.2 Add Paragraph 2.12F to read as follows:

2.12F When current supply leads serve partially equipped circuits or circuit features that has the terminating point apparatus furnished, such as terminal strips, connectors, etc., the current supply leads should be terminated at that point.
