

TEST OF DISTRICT SELECTORS FOR OVERFLOW TONE

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section describes a method for testing the district overflow common lead for continuity.

1.02 This practice has been reissued to simplify the test.

2. APPARATUS

2.01 No. 528 or equivalent head receiver with cords and test picks.

3. METHOD

3.01 Connect one cord of the head set to ground and hold the test pick of the other cord on the cam spring which furnishes the overflow tone to the top sequence switch of the district

frame to be tested. The overflow tone should be heard.

3.02 Repeat the operation on the bottom sequence switch of the district frame.

3.03 The other side of the district frame may be tested in the same manner.

3.04 Extreme care should be practiced so as not to touch any other cam spring or cam as this may interfere with a regular call.

4. REPORTS

4.01 The required record for this test should be entered on the proper form.
