

TABLE TYPE WAGONS
PER DRAWING ED-90595

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section describes the table type wagon assemblies per Drawing ED-90595-01 or -70 and ED-90603-01 which are for use in supporting central office portable test equipment, crossconnecting wire spools and soldering coppers.

1.02 This issue, which replaces Issue C, is issued to include additional table type wagon assembly group numbers.

2. DESCRIPTION

2.01 The table type wagon consists of two sheet metal trays welded to four angle iron upright supports. The exposed metal of the wagon is finished in aluminum or grey enamel. Large rubber tired disc wheels are provided on the front legs and rubber tired swivel casters are provided on the rear legs. A black corrugated rubber switchboard matting is used in both the upper and lower trays.

2.02 A short rigid handle is provided and it will not be necessary, ordinarily, to lift one end of the wagon to move it from one location to another.

2.03 The table type wagon is of sufficient strength to safely support 100 pounds on the top tray and 50 pounds on the lower tray.

2.04 The table type wagon assemblies are grouped as follows:

Table Wagon ED-90595-01 (Group)

- Group 1: One table type wagon with two 12" by 24" trays.
- Group 2: One table type wagon with two 12" by 40" trays.
- Group 3: One group 1 table type wagon, less rubber matting, but equipped with wire spool rack, fanning strip, soldering copper holder and two metal 4" x 4" x 4" sand boxes.
- Group 5: Material required to equip existing wagons with leg guards.

Table Wagon ED-90603-01 Group 1:

One table type wagon with two 18" by 43" trays.

NOTE: This ED-90603 type wagon is to be used in toll terminal rooms only.
