 BRUSHES, BLOCKING AND BUSYING TOOLS

BRUSH, FULLER BRUSH COMPANY, NO. Q-3276



A radial type brush having a twisted wire core 3-5/8 inches in length with 2 inches of spiral arranged bristles 3/8 inch in diameter.

Used with a vacuum head of local design for cleaning sequence switch cams in panel offices.


BLOCKING TOOL, ROLLING LADDER, PER DRAWING A-3585



This tool consists of a wooden block, equipped with a corrugated rubber base, and having the top side recessed to accommodate a rolling ladder floor wheel.

For use in placing under a ladder floor wheel to temporarily retain the ladder in a stationary position.


BUSYING TOOL, TRUNK HUNTING, PER DRAWING A-3582



This tool consists of a No. 18BA resistance, modified by means of equipping one terminal with a brass eyelet, a steel spring and a fiber washer.

For use in battery cutoff relay offices for temporarily making the last line of a P.B.X. trunk group trunk-hunting where a subscriber line overflow register is connected to a vacant final terminal immediately above.

This tool consists of a piece of No. 18 gauge (.041") steel piano wire, shaped as per above dimensions and insulated in part with cambric tubing.

For use on intermediate distributing frames in dial offices in connection with make-busy cords for P.B.X. trunks.
