

DESIGNATION STRIPS AND CARDS

1.00 GENERAL

Designation cards are used to indicate on which key or push button a particular PBX extension number, a central office line number, or another service appears on multibutton telephone sets or key equipments.

2.00 DESIGNATION CARDS AND STRIPS




Fig. 1 — E-2804-G

2.01 Appropriate designation cards for 400-, 500-, and 600-type multibutton telephone sets and key equipments are shown in Fig. 1 through 7.

DESCRIPTION

Form has horizontal perforations with holes punched to correspond with pins in transparent cover. Six spaces are provided horizontally for information such as hold, line number, etc. Made in 6-button set size; when used on 4-button set, the extreme left and right spaces should be cut off.

USE

Designation card for 4- and 6-button 440- and 460-type key telephone sets.




Fig. 2 — E-2961

DESCRIPTION

Similar to form E-2804-G. The spaces are colored amber, green, white, and red, respectively, to correspond to the color of lamps in 20-type indicators.

USE

On key telephone sets at 755A PBX stations employing 20-type indicators.

DESCRIPTION

Card has adhesive strip for holding old designation card ; two pull tabs for easy removal by customer. Bottom half of card is notched to fit pins of holder. Covers new designation card.

USE

As temporary designation strip prior to cutovers or number changes. For 440- and 460-type key telephone sets.




Fig. 4 – E-4227-G

DESCRIPTION

Horizontal perforations. Six spaces for information from left to right. Form E-4521-G is the same as E-4227-G except for an adhesive back.

USE

On 4- and 6-button 540- and 560-type key telephone sets. When used on 4-button set, extreme left and right spaces should be removed. Form E-4521-G is used as a temporary designation card prior to cutovers or number changes.




Fig. 7 – E-4098

DESCRIPTION

Card is perforated horizontally. Five vertical spaces with guide lines.

USE

Used with 9A card holder on 101- and 102-type key equipment when designation space provided in the key box is inadequate.

2.02 The code number of designation strips and piece part numbers of associated acetate windows are shown in Table A. These designation strips are used with keys which are not equipped with designation card holders.
