CORDING

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the cording for the 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, and 215 types of hand telephone sets and also the combination of a corded B type hand set mounting with an E1B hand set where this combination may be used interchangeably with the foregoing hand telephone sets.

1.02 Cording for coded sidetone hand telephone sets (102, 103, 104, and 105 types) is the same as for the related anti-sidetone type sets shown herein except that the black conductor of the hand set mounting cord is omitted.

1.03 **Reason for Issue:** This section is issued to replace cording information for desk type hand telephone sets previously covered in Sections C32.160 and C32.161 and to include cording for 204, 208 and 215 types of hand telephone sets.




Fig. 1—D1 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 2—B1 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 3—D1 Type Hand Set Mounting.






Fig. 4—B1 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 7—D5 Type Hand Set Mounting.





Fig. 8—D3 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 10—D8 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 11—D1 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 12—B1 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 13—D1 Type Hand Set Mounting.






Fig. 16—B6 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 19—E4 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 20—D5 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 21—D5 Type Hand Set Mounting.





Fig. 22—D3 Type Hand Set Mounting.




Fig. 24—D8 Type Hand Set Mounting.

1. GENERAL




Fig. 25—D2 Type Hand Set Mounting





Fig. 26—B2 Type Hand Set Mounting




Fig. 28—D10 Type Hand Set Mounting

1.01 This addendum supplements Section C32.164, Issue 1. It was previously issued to add cording for the 103A, B, C, 205G, H, J, 206M, N and P hand telephone sets, to include precautionary information regarding the contact of cord tips with a dial mounting screw and to change the designation of Figs. 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Addendum C32.164, Issue 1, to Figs. 25, 26, 27 and 28, respectively.

1.02 This addendum is reissued to include cording for sets with 4- and 5-type twin contact dials, also 6-type dials. Paragraphs 1.04 and 1.05 are added.

1.04 Care should be exercised in connecting conductors to terminal "R" of the 4- and 5-type dials and terminal "W" of the 6-type dials to be certain that the cord tips do not come into contact with the adjacent dial mounting screw or the flange of the hand set mounting.




Fig. 29—4- and 5-Twin Contact Dials

1.05 The cording of sets having single contact 4- and 5-type dials should be in accordance with Figs. 11 to 28 inclusive. The same information, other than dial cording, applies to sets with twin contact 4- and 5-type dials as well as 6-type dials. Typical cording for these latter dials is shown in Figs. 29 and 30. The same general principles of cording should be followed in the case of sets having a different number of dial conductors.
