

SIDETONE DESK STANDS 20, 40, 50, 51 AND 52 TYPES CORDING

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the cording for the 20, 40, 50, 51 and 52 types of desk stands when such stands are used at regular manual or dial common battery stations.

1.02 The cording arrangements shown herein include only those cords of the types specified in the section covering "Station Cords."

1.03 Where cords with unprotected tips are used with 50 type desk stands, cover shanks of cord tips with friction tape.



TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



TYPICAL BASE FOR 50 TYPE DESK STANDS



TERMINAL PLATE








50 - CM DESK STAND





TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



40 - CN AND 20 - CN DESK STANDS





TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



TYPICAL BASE FOR 50 TYPE DESK STANDS



51 - CM DESK STAND



51 - AL DESK STAND



51 - CN DESK STAND



TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



51 - C DESK STAND



TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



51 - CN DESK STAND



TERMINAL PLATE - BACK



51 - R DESK STAND


