# ANTI-SIDETONE DESK STANDS 120, 140, 151 AND 152 TYPES CORDING

## 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the cording for the 120, 140, 151 and 152 types of desk stands when such stands are used at regular manual or dial common battery stations.


1.02 The cording arrangements shown herein include only those desk stand cords of the types which can also be used with hand set mountings and, therefore, are of the types specified in the section covering "Station Cords."

1.03 Number 1 residence system and No. 2 P.B.X. are not covered in this section as no anti-sidetone equipment has been standardized for these services.

140 - AL AND 120 - AL DESK STAND



151 - S DESK STAND



151 - AL AND 152 - AB DESK STANDS



151 - S DESK STAND



151-C DESK STAND



151-R DESK STAND


