1.02 This section provides an alphabetical index of the active Bell System Practices in the C43 Group. It covers items such as telephone answering sets, auxiliary signals, head telephone sets, loudspeaker sets, modular station apparatus, recorder connectors, station control keys, and tele-trainers. It also covers backboards, buzzers and bells, dry cells, dry batteries, and lamp indicators. Alphabetical headings are also provided for information in other groups relating to associated station apparatus.

1.03 Sections are listed under headings derived from the principal items in the title. Headings other than those appearing in the title are also used if such headings are applicable to the material covered in the section. In addition, headings are included covering terms which may very likely come to mind when looking for specific information.

1.04 An asterisk (*) following a section number listed in the index indicates that the section is being prepared and is expected to be re-
