WOOD POLE BRACKETS

GENERAL

NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This Addendum changes Section G22.125.1, Paragraph 1.04 relative to the use of wooden pole brackets. It also modifies Paragraph 1.05 of Section G22.125.1 to bring it into conformity with California legal requirements.

A cross-reference "See Addendum" should be marked at Paragraph 1.04 and 1.05 of Section G22.125.1 which are replaced herein.

1. GENERAL

1.04 Wooden pole brackets are suitable for use in supporting rural, exchange and toll open wire circuits in lines where the use of crossarms is not necessary.

Note: Where two or more circuits are to be supported initially, place crossarms in all cases.

1.05 On poles used jointly with an electric light or power company, one pair of brackets may be attached on one side of the pole provided the poles are located on private property and a minimum vertical separation of 5 feet is maintained and both classifications of circuits are used for service to the same party.
