

POLE ATTACHMENTS
REPAIRING CROSSARMS

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section provides for the use of Crossarm Reinforcing Straps to repair split crossarms.

2. PLACING REINFORCING STRAPS

2.01 When crossarms are found to have split along the line of the pin holes and the damage is not extensive, the arms may be repaired by reinforcement with crossarm reinforcing straps to hold the pins in place and to prevent further splitting. The splitting usually occurs at the end of the crossarm and the placing of reinforcing straps between the outer pin and the end of the arm is usually sufficient to remedy this condition. If reinforcing straps at one or both ends of the crossarm would not be adequate, consult your supervisor regarding the replacement of the crossarm.

2.02 Attach the crossarm reinforcing straps as shown in the following illustration.
