SPLICE CASE AND T-TYPE CABLE TERMINALS

LOCATION

NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements Section G50.705.1 and is being issued to provide instructions on location of terminal cases at a wooden extension or cable arm.

The following paragraphs should be marked, "See Addendum," and treated as indicated.

3. TERMINAL CASE LOCATION

3.04 Where the case is installed adjacent to a dead end pole, the terminal case should be located the same as cases installed at junctions of underground and aerial cables. See illustration at Paragraph 3.05.

3.06 Where a terminal case is installed at a false dead end, the location of the case should be shifted, so that the case can be properly attached to the suspension strand.

4. TERMINAL CASE AT EXTENSION ARM

4.01 Where the suspension strand is attached to a wooden extension or cable arm, the terminal case should be located 5" from the suspension clamp bolt when the cable arm is mounted on the same side of the pole as the terminal case, and 15" from the bolt when the arm is mounted on the opposite side.
