

AERIAL CABLE SUPPORTS

ARRANGEMENT

NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements Section G52. 135. 2 and is being issued to provide additional instructions for placing supports on large lead sleeves and at corner poles where branch cables are involved.

The cross-reference, "See Addendum" should be written at Paragraph 2. 02 (b) which is supplemented and following Paragraph 1. 04 and Paragraph 2. 02 (b) to indicate additional information.

1. GENERAL

1. 05 Where a large size lead sleeve is required and the space between the messenger and the sleeve measures $3/4$ inch or less, lashed cable supports and cable spacers may be used to support the sleeve.

2. CORNER POLES

2. 02 (b) In the sketch associated with Paragraph 2. 02 (b) the strand continuity should be maintained with No. 6 BRC Solid R Wire or a piece of strand of the same size as the suspension strand. Use strand in corrosive areas.

(c) At corner poles where there is a branch cable, and the radius of the bend permits, support the branch cable to the strand with a support between the thimble eye nut and the 3-bolt clamp.
