

BLOCK AND HOUSE CABLE  
CLAMPING CABLES IN BUILDINGS

NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum supplements Section G53. 115. 1. It contains information about supporting several small cables with one cable clamp and the use of U cable guards to support cables across narrow passage ways.

"See Addendum" should be written following Paragraph 3. 06 to indicate the inclusion of additional instructions and at Paragraph 5. 01 which is supplemented.

3. PARALLELING MAIN CABLE WITH STUB OR BRANCH CABLES

3. 07 Where a number of small cables are to be mounted on a masonry, wood or metal surface, space limitations sometimes make it impractical to use individual fasteners. A saving in space can be effected by combining these cables in one or more groups under a single cable clamp, cable strap or adjustable sleeve strap, according to the size of the cables involved.

5. CROSSING PASSAGE WAYS

5. 01 U cable guard may be substituted for pipe if the span does not exceed 6 feet.
