1. GENERAL


1.01 This section prescribes the methods of marking and changing markings in the F Type Cable Terminal. The materials employed in marking this terminal are covered in Section G61.160, "Terminals—Materials, Terms and Abbreviations Used in Marking Terminals."

2. MARKING TERMINAL


2.01 Where it is the practice to identify cable pair terminations in the outside plant distribution system, one of the following methods can be employed in marking the F Type Cable Terminal. Place markings either on the porcelain fanning strips or on a Terminal Tag and attach it to cable stub above the top of the terminal.

- (a) Rubber Stamp Method. Stamp pair numbers and cable and terminal numbers when specified by means of the Terminal Numeral Stamp or Terminal Numeral Stamping Set.

- (b) Terminal Tag Method. Stamp pair numbers and cable number when specified on the tag by means of the Steel Numbering Die. When a terminal number is specified, stamp this number on a second tag to be placed directly under the other tag.



3. CHANGING TERMINAL MARKINGS

3.01 Terminal markings shall be changed in accordance with the following instructions:

- (a) Where the Rubber Stamp method has been used, remove markings by means of a rubber eraser and stamp new markings.
- (b) Where the Terminal Tag method has been used, discard the old tag and place a tag stamped with the new markings.
