NOTES CONCERNING THIS ADDENDUM

This addendum has been reissued to delete certain splicing and marking information which is not standard for use in this region.

1. GENERAL

1.03 Binding post numbers are used to identify both the feeder, cable pairs and the distribution cable pairs. All references to pair numbers in this Practice are for splicing purposes only.

4. SPLICING TERMINALS

4.03 Attach the stub cable to the mounting surface using cable clamps on masonry walls, and cable straps on poles in accordance with the Section of the Practices covering Clamps and Straps for Cable.

4.04 Attach the stub cable to the mounting surface in accordance with Paragraph 4.03 of this addendum. The 24 inch measurement to the opening of the branch splice given in the illustration should be changed to read 30 inches.

4.05 and 4.06 Canceled - The information contained in these paragraphs is not standard for use in this area.
