synopsis: Preliminary planning information for a new, light-traffic, electronic dial PBX, coded the 802A.

A new, light-traffic, electronic switching system, encoded the 802A, is now under development at the Customer Telephone System Switching Center at Denver, Colorado.

The 802A is intended primarily for Hotel/Motel service in the 0-400 line range. A field trial of this system is scheduled for August, 1971. Production models are to be available by November, 1971.
