Abstract

Provides notification of date for the split of the 305 NPA and introduction of the new 407 NPA in Florida.

Substantial telephone number growth in southeastern Florida necessitates the splitting of the existing 305 Numbering Plan Area (NPA) and the introduction of the new 407 NPA. The 305 NPA code will continue to be used in the territory including Broward, Dade and Monroe counties. The new 407 NPA will embrace the remaining territory contained in the existing 305 NPA. The attached map illustrates the new NPA configuration as it will appear after the split.

We have been advised by Southern Bell that the split is scheduled for 2:00 A.M. EDT, on April 16, 1988. In addition, to minimize the impact upon call completions, Southern Bell has advised that either 305 or 407 NPAs will be accepted in a called address until June 18, 1988. On that date, the permissive dialing period will terminate, and calls that are destined for the 305 NPA or 407 NPA must be dialed and routed with the correct NPA or the calls will be routed to intercept.

Local exchange routing change information regarding the 305/407 split will be incorporated into the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) and should be available approximately three months prior to the cutover.
