Abstract

This IL provides industry notification of the impending split of the 615 NPA.

Letter information (includes safety liability disclaimer (if applicable), ordering information, originator's signature information)

We have been advised by BellSouth Telecommunications that substantial telephone number growth in the central and eastern sections of Tennessee necessitates splitting the existing 615 NPA and the simultaneous introduction of a new 423 NPA.

The Nashville Local Access and Transport Area (LATA) will retain the 615 NPA and the remainder of the current 615 NPA, including the Chattanooga, Knoxville, and Johnson City LATAs in the eastern part of the state, will be transferred to the new 423 NPA.

The split of the 615 NPA, and the beginning of a permissive dialing period, is scheduled for 12:01 AM Central Standard Time, Monday, September 11, 1995. The permissive dialing period will end at 12:01 AM Central Standard Time on Monday, February 26, 1996. During the permissive dialing period, either 615 or 423 will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 423 NPA. After the permissive period, calls dialed with incorrect NPA codes, as defined in the NPA split information published in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG), will be routed to intercept. Changes in the local exchange routing information will be incorporated into the LERG and the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG) and will be available by March 30, 1995.

BellSouth will convert all pertinent records to 423 the weekend of September 8, 1995. This includes customer service records and associated NPA information in other systems. After September 11, 1995, all inquiries must refer to the correct NPA code. The attached map illustrates the 615 and 423 configuration after the split. A listing of the communities to be served by each area code after the split is also attached.

A test number for the new 423 NPA will be established on or about August 1, 1995 with details to be provided later.

The following dialing plan will continue for all NPAs in Tennessee:

- All Home NPA (HNPA) "local" calls will be dialed on a seven digit basis with no prefix; i.e., NXX + XXXX (seven digits).
- All HNPA direct dialed "toll" calls (generally calls that incur an additional charge) will be dialed with a prefix "1" and then ten digits; i.e., 1 + HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + ten digits). Dialing of 1 + seven digits on toll calls within the HNPA is not permitted.
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and ten digits; i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + ten digits). NOTE - Existing seven digit local dialing across NPA boundaries initially will be maintained.
- All operator assisted calls (both HNPA and FNPA) including credit card, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" prefix and ten digits; i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX.


