**Abstract:**

This IL provides industry notification of the introduction of NPA 972 for relief of the 214 NPA.

**Letter Information (includes safety liability disclaimer (if applicable), ordering information, originator's signature information)**

We have been advised by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company that substantial telephone number growth in the Dallas area necessitates the activation of an additional NPA to serve the area. The new NPA, 972, will go into service at 12:01 AM on February 1, 1996. The 972 NPA will be assigned within the same geographic area where the existing 214 NPA is in effect. This method of relief, called an overlay, will be utilized instead of the traditional NPA split. No number changes will be required.

Southwestern Bell informs us that the 972 NPA will be implemented as a "general purpose" overlay. Assignments will be made to all customers, wireless and wireline.

A permissive dialing period will be established on February 1, 1996 and will last 6 months, until August 1, 1996. During the permissive period the dialing procedures for the 214 and 972 NPAs will be as follows:

- Home NPA (HNPA) direct dialed local calls within the 214 NPA that are currently dialed on a 7 digit basis may continue to be dialed on a 7 digit basis, i.e., NXX + XXXX, or on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., 214 + NXX + XXXX (10 digits).
- HNPA direct dialed local calls made within the 972 NPA will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., 972 + NXX + XXXX (10 digits).
- All HNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All Foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed local calls will be dialed on a 10 digit basis with no prefix, i.e., FNPA + NXX + XXXX. This will include all local calls that are made between the 214 and 972 NPAs.
- All FNPA direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX. (1 + 10 digits).
