Abstract

This IL provides industry notification of the impending split of the 803 NPA.

Letter Information (includes safety liability disclaimer (if applicable), ordering information, originator's signature information)

We have been advised by BellSouth Telecommunications that substantial telephone number growth throughout the state of South Carolina necessitates splitting the existing 803 NPA and the simultaneous introduction of a new 864 NPA.

The Greenville Local Access and Transport Area (LATA) in the northwest corner of the state will change to the 864 NPA while the remainder of the state, including the Charleston, Columbia, and Florence LATAs, will retain the existing 803 NPA.

The split of the 803 NPA, and the beginning of a permissive dialing period, is scheduled for 12:01 AM Eastern Standard Time, Sunday, December 3, 1995. The permissive dialing period will end at 12:01 AM Eastern Daylight Time on Wednesday, May 1, 1996. During the permissive dialing period, either 803 or 864 will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 864 NPA. After the permissive period, calls dialed with incorrect NPA codes, as defined in the NPA split information published in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG), will be routed to intercept. Changes in the local exchange routing information will be incorporated into the LERG and the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG) and will be available by June 30, 1995.

BellSouth will convert all pertinent records to 864 the weekend of December 1, 1995. This includes customer service records and associated NPA information in other systems. After December 1, 1995, all inquiries must refer to the correct NPA code. The attached map illustrates the 803 and 864 configuration after the split. A listing of the communities to be served by each area code after the split is also attached.

A test number for the new 864 NPA will be established on or about October 21, 1995 with details to be provided later.



The following dialing procedures will continue for all NPAs in South Carolina:


- All Home NPA (HNPA) "local" calls will be dialed on a seven digit basis with no prefix; i.e., NXX + XXXX (seven digits).
- All HNPA direct dialed "toll" calls (generally calls that incur an additional charge) will be dialed with a prefix "1" and then ten digits; i.e., 1 + HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + ten digits). Dialing of 1+ seven digits on toll calls within the HNPA is not permitted.
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and ten digits; i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + ten digits). NOTE - Existing seven digit local dialing across NPA boundaries initially will be maintained.
- All operator assisted calls (both HNPA and FNPA) including credit card, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" or a "10XXX + 0" prefix and ten digits; i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX; or, 10XXX + 0 + NPA + XXXX.
